

## **Femspectives Launch: 46 Years in the Future – Women’s Film Festivals, then and now (FAQ)**

**Location: Glasgow Women’s Library**

**Event Running Time: 12:30 - 17:00**

### **What is the event?**

46 Years in the Future – Women’s Film Festivals, then and now is the launch event of Femspectives, Glasgow Feminist Film Festival. The screening is also part of the RFN Scotland 6818 programme.

In 1972 the Edinburgh International Film Festival hosted the UK’s first women’s film festival, which was entirely dedicated to the cinematic achievements of women directors. 31 films were screened with the hope to change the canon and film history forever. Today, 46 years later, most of these films are, once again, lost.

At this event, Femspectives will re-visit two films from the original programme and contextualise them anew in our discussion sessions after each screening.

### **What time does the event start?**

The doors will open at 12:00. The event starts at 12:30.

### **When does the first film start?**

The first film will start at 13:00.

### **When does the second film start?**

The second film will start at 16:00.

### **Where is the event?**

### **Are there any age restrictions?**

### **Is the space accessible?**

The Library is wheelchair accessible, with lifts to the first floor and the mezzanine and archive.

An induction loop is available for events – please let a member of staff know if you require this.

The Library has disabled toilets on the ground and first floors. All the Glasgow Women's Library bathrooms are individual closed stalls and are gender-neutral.
